## **BUSINESS:**

Low sugarcane prices push Busoga farmers towards the cliff; by July this year, prices once again fell from shs110,000 to Shs104,000 and later there was a steep decline to Shs96,000 at which it is selling now. Even at that low price, the millers in Busoga do not have the capacity to consume the sugarcane, partly because of limited production capacity. The unpredictable market has given rise to ruthless middlemen, who have enforced an extortionist cartel permit system, which has pushed farmers towards the cliff. Story
