Eskom invests in Kiira dam water controllers: Eskom has replaced the water flow controller at Kiira Power Station in a Shs5b investment. The system, which is also known as the electronic governor upgrade, controls the flow of water through the hydraulic turbines that vary flow, speed and power output. **Story**

KCCA earmarks Shs 9bn to fix potholes in Kampala; KCCA has set aside at least Shs 9 billion to patch potholes dotting nearly all city roads. The money comes from the Authority budget for 2020/2021 for infrastructure works in Kampala which includes road construction. **Story**
